

Career Alphabet Lesson Plan



Objective: The purpose of this activity is for students to think of as many traditional and non traditional careers as possible using all the letters of the alphabet

Activities: Students will list one traditional career and one non traditional career with each letter of the alphabet.

*Example: A Traditional- Architect, A Non Traditional- Astronaut

Students make work alone or in groups.

If time permits, have students share their ideas and vote on most creative ideas.

Materials: Paper and Pencil

Career Charades



Objective: The purpose of this activity is to help students think about various careers and help them to learn more about the career clusters.

Materials: Career Cluster Sheet *(provided by the career specialist)

Activity: Play Career Charades.

Divide your students into groups and have each group take turns acting out different careers.

Discuss the career cluster that fits what the students acted out.

Envisioning Your Future Lesson Plan:

Objective:

The purpose of this lesson is to have the students start visualizing their future so that they begin to have an idea in what they want to achieve in life.

Materials:

Students will need paper and pencil.

Time: 10 Min.

Please begin as soon as class begins.

Activity:

- Have students close their eyes and visualize their future for several minutes.
- Then have them describe in writing what they imagined in their future.
