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Dear Wanda Pontoo,

We received your request for information directed to GeoBlue that was dated July 8<sup>th</sup>. I apologize for the delay, but this was floating around our company before it found its way to me.

GeoBlue itself is not an insurer, but an administrator that is active in the insurance market for international students attending institutes of higher learning under F-1 and J-1 visa programs. We do not have any plans in the K-12 programs or write coverage for US citizens within the United States and I don't believe foreign students would be eligible for Medicaid. So, I could put together a data request to capture the information contained on pages 4 – 9 of this document, but I wanted to check with you first whether you feel our response would be relevant.
