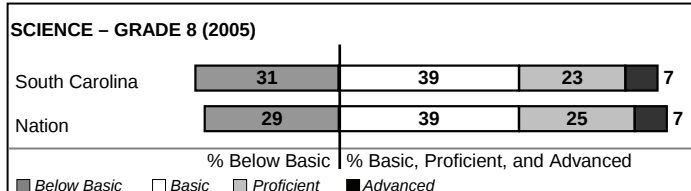
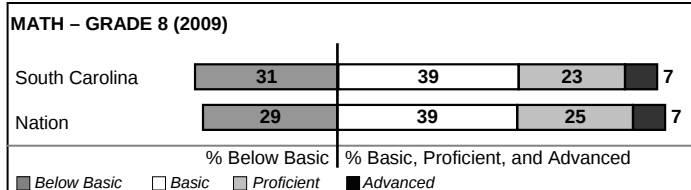
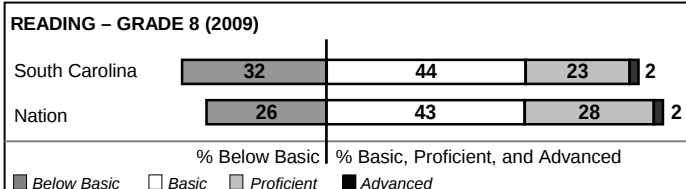

## REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

Abbeville High School has forty-eight certified faculty members working with our students. Among these teachers twenty-three have advanced degrees and sixteen are National Board Certified. This dedication to lifelong learning by our teachers is a benefit to our students and demonstrates a commitment to academic excellence.

The 2010 graduating class of one hundred and thirty continues our tradition of excellence by receiving almost one million two hundred thousand dollars in scholarship money. Thirty-four percent of the graduating class will attend a four-year institution, fifty-five percent will attend a two-year community college, two percent will enlist in the military, one percent will use Vocational Rehabilitations services, and eight percent will be joining the fulltime workforce.

We believe all students have the right to learn in a safe, comfortable, and disciplined environment. We commit ourselves to student success and believe every student should have an opportunity to fulfill his or her potential. We are proud of our school and our community and we look forward to the future.
