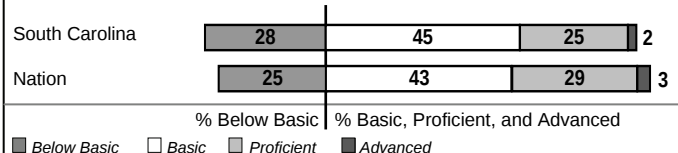
Our School Middle Schools with Students Like Ours Middle schools statewide



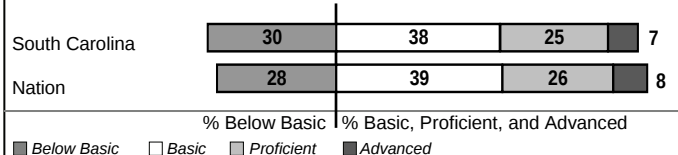

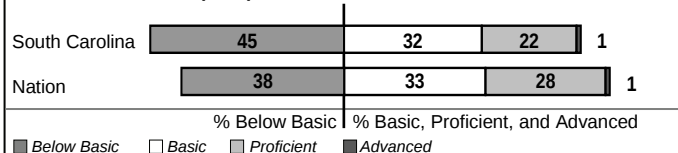
READING - GRADE 8 (2011)

REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

Ralph Chandler Middle School has been serving the families in the Simpsonville and Fork Shoals communities since 2008. RCMS is a family-friendly school where parents, community, and staff work to create a school climate that fosters academic rigor, high expectations, and well-rounded youth. The school continues to grow in enrollment from 560 students in 2008 to 744 students this past school year.

100% of our staff is highly qualified. This staff consists of 41 teachers, 7 support staff members, and 3 administrators. We are proud to have 4 teachers who hold National Board Certification. Many of our professional staff members have received state awards. An 8th grade social studies teacher was named SC History Teacher of the Year, a first year teacher was named the New Teacher of the Year by the South Carolina Business Education Association, and an 8th grade English teacher was nominated for the RBC bank awards where she will be attending the Gilder Lehrman Institute in New Mexico in July. Of the professional staff, thirty percent have less than 10 years' teaching experience, but sixty percent of them hold Master's degrees.

Our most recent state assessment shows that 83% and 86% of our students met or exceeded the standard in ELA and Math respectively. This is a significant improvement from the previous year. Our school Report Card rating improved from Good to Excellent in its Growth rating. As a result, RCMS received a Gold award from the SC Department of Education based on this PASS performance.

Teachers continue to integrate technology making it an integral part of daily instruction. Staff members consistently meet to analyze data which includes reviewing benchmark tests and MAP score. This allows us to provide rigorous academic experiences for our students, and continues to be the foundation for professional development for our teachers.

RCMS is proud of the many accomplishments of our students. 60% of our students were recognized on honor rolls during the year; 72 7th graders qualified for the Duke Talent Identification Program, 190 of our students were enrolled in advanced classes, and 18 8th graders were named Junior Scholars. Our band/strings programs continue to achieve excellent ratings at state and regional events and our drama department produced two shows this year. 7 out of 9 of our athletic teams qualified for the playoffs. 65% of our students and parents participated in student led conferences.

Our school continues to receive extra support from the PTSA and SIC. Teachers were awarded \$6,500 in grants to support instruction and purchase equipment. SIC continues to seek ways to support the efforts of the school. A parent survey was distributed through SIC to determine the needs of students and families. These results will be used to offer classes and programs to support our families during the 2012-2013 school year. In addition, our staff continues to support student needs through mentoring students who do not have support at home.

Our mission, vision, and goals support our work to raise academic achievement of our students. We consistently strive to meet the academic, social, emotional and developmental needs of all of our students.
