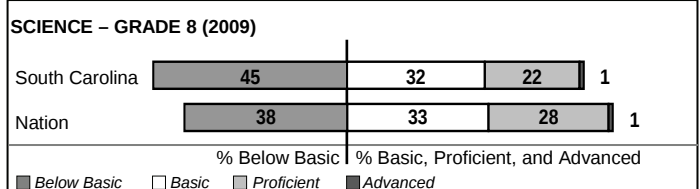
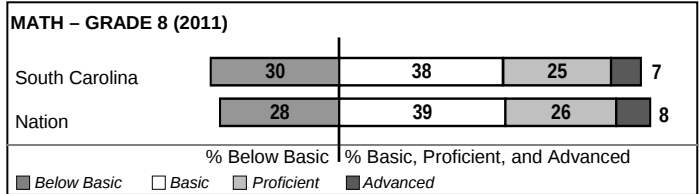
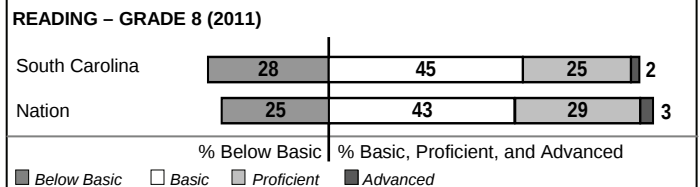
## PASS PERFORMANCE
