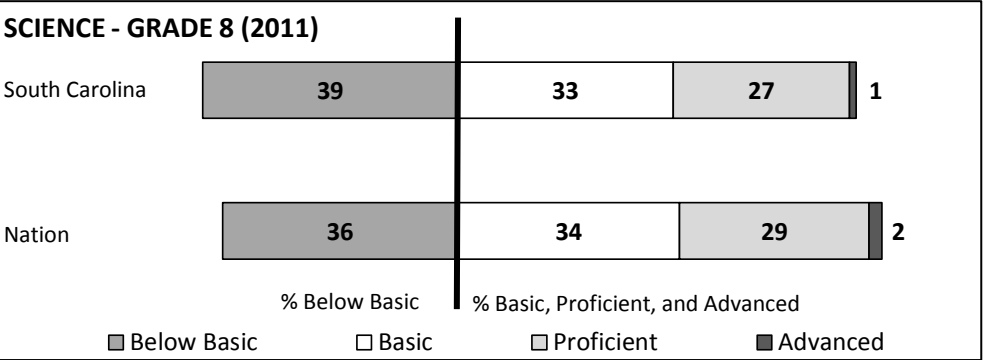
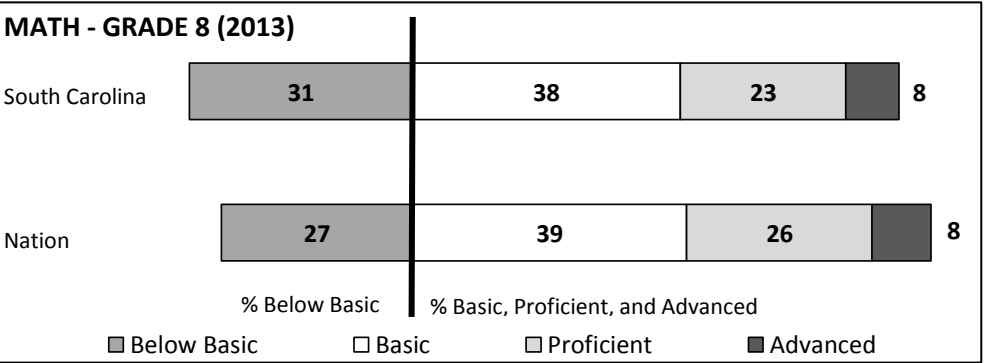
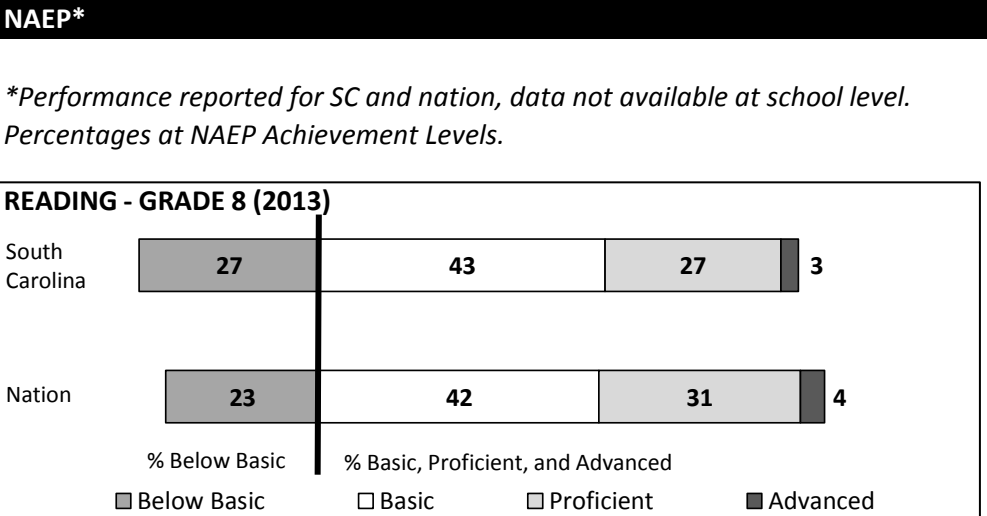

The A. C. Flora School Improvement Council is very proud of the achievements that students have made throughout the 2013-2014 school year. Students have risen to the challenge of taking more rigorous courses and have excelled as a result. This year, Flora's AP participation rate is at an all-time high. We are giving a total of 704 AP exams to 475 AP students – this is 36% of the student body. The Math Team continues to win state, region and national competitions. As of March 2014, Flora is proud to announce one Presidential Scholar, three National Merit Semi-finalists, 20 Palmetto Fellows, 76 Life Scholarships, 80 Hope Scholarships and over \$4,750,790.00 in scholarships! We anticipate that students will earn over \$20,000,000.00 in scholarships. Several programs aimed at supporting students were expanded this year. Falcons in Flight added a Freshman Academy program to raise on-time graduation rates and the Edgenuity program has been expanded to offer credit recovery and credit accrual so that students stay on track for graduation.②

The number of National Board certified teacher has risen to 25. Flora's Strength Coach was named the AAA Strength Coach of the Year for the 2nd year in a row. The Girls Tennis & Girls Golf coaches were both chosen as Region Coaches of the Year. A. C. Flora's Teacher of the Year is a Finalist for the Richland One Teacher of the Year 2014-2015!
